

## 40 Healing Scriptures

from *Healed of Cancer* by Dodie Osteen

**1. Proverbs 4:20-23: The Word of God will save your life.**

*20 My son, pay attention to what I say; turn your ear to my words. 21 Do not let them out of your sight, keep them within your heart; 22 for they are life to those who find them and health to one's whole body. 23 Above all else, guard your heart, for everything you do flows from it.*

**2. Joshua 21:45: God's Word will not fail.**

*45 Not one of all the Lord's good promises to Israel failed; every one was fulfilled.*

**3. Philippians 2:13: God's will - healing - is working in you.**

*13 for it is God who works in you to will and to act in order to fulfill his good purpose.*

**4. Romans 8:11: The Spirit of Life is making your body alive.**

*11 And if the Spirit of him who raised Jesus from the dead is living in you, he who raised Christ from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies because of his Spirit who lives in you.*

**5. 2 Corinthians 1:20: God is for you.**

*20 For no matter how many promises God has made, they are "Yes" in Christ. And so through him the "Amen" is spoken by us to the glory of God.*

**6. Matthew 8:2-3: It is God's will for you to be healed.**

*2 A man with leprosy came and knelt before him and said, "Lord, if you are willing, you can make me clean." 3 Jesus reached out his hand and touched the man. "I am willing," he said. "Be clean!" Immediately he was cleansed of his leprosy.*

**7. Exodus 15:26: Obey God's Word and be healed.**

*26 He said, "If you listen carefully to the Lord your God and do what is right in his eyes, if you pay attention to his commands and keep all his decrees, I will not bring on you any of the diseases I brought on the Egyptians, for I am the Lord, who heals you."*

**8. Exodus 23:25: Serve the Lord and healing will be yours.**

*25 Worship the Lord your God, and his blessing will be on your food and water. I will take away sickness from among you.*

**9. Deuteronomy 7:15: God takes all sickness away from you.**

*15 The Lord will keep you free from every disease. He will not inflict on you the horrible diseases you knew in Egypt, but he will inflict them on all who hate you.*

**10. Malachi 3:10: Obey all God's commandments and receive His blessings.**

*10 Bring the whole tithe into the storehouse, that there may be food in my house. Test me in this," says the Lord Almighty, "and see if I will not throw open the floodgates of heaven and pour out so much blessing that there will not be room enough to store it.*

**11. Psalm 103:1-5: One of God's benefits is healing.**

*1 Praise the Lord, my soul; all my inmost being, praise his holy name. 2 Praise the Lord, my soul, and forget not all his benefits—3 who forgives all your sins and heals all your diseases, 4 who redeems your life from the pit and crowns you with love and compassion, 5 who satisfies your desires with good things so that your youth is renewed like the eagle's.*

**12. Psalm 107:20: God's Word is healing.**

*20 He sent out his word and healed them; he rescued them from the grave.*

**13. Psalm 118:17: God wants you to live.**

*17 I will not die but live, and will proclaim what the Lord has done.*

**14. Deuteronomy 30:19: Choose to live. Be a fighter!**

*19 This day I call the heavens and the earth as witnesses against you that I have set before you life and death, blessings and curses. Now choose life, so that you and your children may live.*

**15. Psalm 91:16: You will live a long life.**

*16 With long life I will satisfy him and show him my salvation.*

**16. Isaiah 53:5: Jesus bore your sins and your sickness.**

*5 But he was pierced for our transgressions, he was crushed for our iniquities; the punishment that brought us peace was on him, and by his wounds we are healed.*

**17. Jeremiah 30:17: God will restore your health.**

*17 But I will restore you to health and heal your wounds,' declares the Lord, 'because you are called an outcast, Zion for whom no one cares.'*

**18. Matthew 18:18: You can take authority over the sickness in your body.**

18 *“Truly I tell you, whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven.*

**19. Matthew 18:19: Agree with someone for your healing.**

19 *“Again, truly I tell you that if two of you on earth agree about anything they ask for, it will be done for them by my Father in heaven.*

**20. Mark 11:22-23: What you say will make a difference.**

22 *“Have faith in God,” Jesus answered. 23 “Truly I tell you, if anyone says to this mountain, ‘Go, throw yourself into the sea,’ and does not doubt in their heart but believes that what they say will happen, it will be done for them.*

**21. Mark 11:24: Believe and you will receive.**

24 *Therefore I tell you, whatever you ask for in prayer, believe that you have received it, and it will be yours.*

**22. Isaiah 43:25-26: Plead your case to God.**

25 *“I, even I, am he who blots out your transgressions, for my own sake, and remembers your sins no more. 26 Review the past for me, let us argue the matter together; state the case for your innocence.*

**23. Mark 16:17-18: Have someone lay hands on you for healing.**

17 *And these signs will accompany those who believe: In my name they will drive out demons; they will speak in new tongues; 18 they will pick up snakes with their hands; and when they drink deadly poison, it will not hurt them at all; they will place their hands on sick people, and they will get well.”*

**24. John 9:31: Worship God.**

31 *We know that God does not listen to sinners. He listens to the godly person who does his will.*

**25. John 10:10: The devil wants to kill you; God wants to heal you.**

10 *The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I have come that they may have life, and have it to the full.*

**26. Galatians 3:13-14: You are redeemed from the curse.**

13 *Christ redeemed us from the curse of the law by becoming a curse for us, for it is written: “Cursed is everyone who is hung on a pole.” 14 He redeemed us in order that the blessing given to Abraham might come to the Gentiles through Christ Jesus, so that by faith we might receive the promise of the Spirit.*

**27. Hebrews 10:23: You will not waver in your faith.**

23 *Let us hold unwaveringly to the hope we profess, for he who promised is faithful.*

**28. Hebrews 10:35: You can have confidence in God and His Word.**

35 *So do not throw away your confidence; it will be richly rewarded.*

**29. Joel 3:10: You can find strength in God and His Word.**

10 *Beat your plowshares into swords and your pruning hooks into spears. Let the weakling say, “I am strong!”*

**30. Hebrews 13:8: Jesus Christ has never changed. What He did in the Bible, He will do for you today.**

8 *Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and forever.*

**31. 3 John 2: God’s highest wish is for you to be well.**

2 *Dear friend, I pray that you may enjoy good health and that all may go well with you, even as your soul is getting along well.*

**32. James 5:14-15: Be anointed with oil by a Christian who believes in healing.**

14 *Is anyone among you sick? Let them call the elders of the church to pray over them and anoint them with oil in the name of the Lord. 15 And the prayer offered in faith will make the sick person well; the Lord will raise them up. If they have sinned, they will be forgiven.*

**33. 1 Peter 2:24: Jesus has already paid the price for our healing.**

24 *“He himself bore our sins” in his body on the cross, so that we might die to sins and live for righteousness; “by his wounds you have been healed.”*

**34. 1 John 5:14-15: Be confident in your prayers.**

14 *This is the confidence we have in approaching God: that if we ask anything according to his will, he hears us. 15 And if we know that he hears us—whatever we ask—we know that we have what we asked of him.*

**35. 1 John 3:21-22: God answers the prayers of those who keep His commandments.**

21 *Dear friends, if our hearts do not condemn us, we have confidence before God 22 and receive from him anything we ask, because we keep his commands and do what pleases him.*

**36. 2 Timothy 1:7: Fear is not of God. Rebuke it!**

*7 For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power and love and self-discipline.*

**37. 2 Corinthians 10:4-5: Cast down those thoughts and imaginations that don't line up with the Word of God.**

*4 The weapons we fight with are not the weapons of the world. On the contrary, they have divine power to demolish strongholds. 5 We demolish arguments and every pretension that sets itself up against the knowledge of God, and we take captive every thought to make it obedient to Christ.*

**38. Ephesians 6:10-13: Be strong in the Lord's power. Put on His armor to fight for your healing.**

*10 Finally, be strong in the Lord and in his mighty power. 11 Put on the full armor of God, so that you can take your stand against the devil's schemes. 12 For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the powers of this dark world and against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms. 13 Therefore put on the full armor of God, so that when the day of evil comes, you may be able to stand your ground, and after you have done everything, to stand.*

**39. Revelation 12:11: Give testimony of your healing.**

*11 They triumphed over him by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony; they did not love their lives so much as to shrink from death.*

**40. Nahum 1:9: Your sickness will leave and not come back again.**

*9 Whatever they plot against the Lord he will bring to an end; trouble will not come a second time.*
